Purpose of data processing

Your data will be processed by Quest Leibniz Research School for the purpose of organizing and conducting the conference "Quantum Metrology and Physics beyond the Standard Model". The

submitted abstracts will be published in a programme booklet. The programme will be published on the website and will be made available to the participants as a print version.

Legal basis of data processing

The legal basis for the data processing of the mandatory data in the registration form is Art. 6 Para. 1 b) of the GDPR. In addition, further optional data may be entered voluntarily in the registration form. The legal basis for the data processing of the optional data is the consent pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a) GDPR and Art. 9 para 2 lit. a) GDPR for processing special categories of personal data (e.g. health data).

Obligation to provide data

You are not obliged to provide such information, but participation in the event is only possible if you provide us with the required data, which is referred to as mandatory information. The communication of further optional data is not necessary and is voluntary.

Withdrawal of consent

You may withdraw your consent to the processing of optional data pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a) GDPR at any time with effect for the future. In this case, we will no longer process this data and delete it. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

Storage period

We process your data for as long as is necessary for the planning and concluding execution of the event or due to applicable legal provisions such as the obligation to retain invoice documents. Should you wish your data to be deleted, we will delete your data immediately, unless there are legal obligations to retain it.
